

Camp Resolute is at 75 Hudson Rd in Bolton, very close to where routes 85 & 117 meet. We will be staying on the BOY SCOUT SIDE OF THE LAKE. It's called the Paul Robsham Jr. Scout Reservation and has a little 1/2 dirt, 1/2 paved road entry. Pull down into the lot and park there for the night. **We are staying at the Rifle Range Cabin Site.** From the parking lot, walk up the dirt road past the waterfront. When you reach the paved area outside the Dining Hall, bear right at the fork (basketball net) and continue down the dirt road. **FYI, the REAL working bathrooms are located just to your right here, so you will become very familiar with this spot!** Continue down the road past the first cabin on your left (Shaughnessy Lodge). The road will dip and curve until you pass over the old Train Trestle. From here you will see the Rifle Range Cabin about 100 yds straight ahead. If you missed the right turn at the basketball net, you will end up at the ball field. That's OK. You can either turn around and go back or cross the ball field and go to the right and you will pick up the Train Trestle.

We should all arrive about 1:00pm Saturday and plan on leaving sometime Sunday morning. If you plan on coming late, leaving early, going back and forth or all of the above, please let me know so we don't send the search parties out for you. **If you need to, call Dan at 774-285-9565 or John Hurley at 508-510-1321.**

Itinerary from 2011

Saturday

- 1:00 – 2:00 pm – Scouts gather wood and learn some knot tying (Boy Scouts from Troop 92 will lead this session)
- 2:00 – 3:30 pm – Snack and pick up sports (waffle ball and soccer)
- 3:30 – 4:30 pm – Organized hike through resolute
- 4:30 – 5:30 pm – Fire safety – we will also build our camp fire
- 5:30 – 6:30 pm – Dinner served (Kids: dogs, grilled cheese, corn on the cob, etc. Adults: Chicken, steak tips, salad and corn) - There will be no nuts due to allergies.
- 6:30 – 7:15 pm – Camp clean up and First Aid Training
- 7:15 – 8:00 pm – Games and running off that energy
- 8:00 – 10:00 pm – Camp fire, dessert (make your own cookies, hot chocolate and S' Mores – life is good for these kids) – There will be no nuts due to allergies.
- 10:00 – 11:00 pm – settle the Scouts and shut down for the night – I hope you get some sleep

Sunday

- Sun up – 9:30 am – Break camp, breakfast and clean up
- 9:30 – 11:00 am – final clean up, running around and snack

Ok, now, let's get the DON'TS out of the way:

- No vehicles allowed in the camp - park in the parking lot only!
- No knives, axes, hatchets, saws or other cutting tools
- No electronics - except for cell phones
- No soda, alcohol, Red Bull, etc.
- No smoking in the camp- its only allowed in the parking lot.
- No snacks that include nuts of any kind - bring some treats if you like, but we will have plenty of food and snacks

- No running or night games
- No aerosols
- No pets
- No flames or heat sources in tents

In general, stick to the scout rule of leaving no trace behind.

If you still want to come after all of that, here are some things you will want to bring:

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Flashlight(s) - the headlight style are popular with the boys and you don't have to worry about them losing them so much
- Warm clothing for nighttime (having a hat and gloves wouldn't be such a bad idea)
- Tent
 - o If you requested a spot in the cabin, bring a fitted twin sheet
- Toothbrush and paste
- Folding chairs for around the fire
- A wagon to bring your stuff up from the parking lot - YOU REALLY WANT TO BRING THIS!!
- Earplugs
- A camera
- Pack T-shirts for the Boys and Leaders should be worn
- Don't forget your bug spray
