Southborough Food Pantry
for the Winter!



Last year we collected over 9,500 lbs of food for the Southborough Food Pantry! Our goal this year is to collect 10,000 or more. In order to achieve this, **we need all our scouts to help!** The Southborough Food Pantry currently serves 126 people (ages 6 months to 83 years). All the food raised in Southborough goes to Southborough residents.

- ✦ Scouts can collect bags and routes from 8 a.m. – 11 a.m. on Saturday, **October 26th** at the Pilgrim Church. Scouts should hang the bags on mailboxes that day.
- ✦ Bags should be picked up between 9 a.m. and 12 noon on, Saturday, **November 2nd**. Please bring bags to the Pilgrim Church by 1 p.m.
- ✦ We are asking that EVERY SCOUT in Southborough please make a yard sign reminding people that Saturday the 2nd is Food Pick Up Day. Suggested text “Scouting For Food Pick Up Saturday November 2nd 9 a.m.” Please have the sign in your front yard somewhere visible from the street, starting Monday, October 28th until Saturday 2nd of November.
- ✦ We include a flyer in every bag explaining Southborough Scouting for Food. Please consider also adding a personal flyer to each bag. Many scouts have found this increases the amount of food they collect.
- ✦ We are looking for volunteers (kids and adults) to help weigh, sort, and pack food on Saturday November 2nd between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. If you can donate an hour or 2 at Pilgrim Church to help with the incoming donations please contact either
